- Why does the writer need to be washed?

This is in one of King David's prayers to God. King David was a man who had committed great sin, but also a man who knew the depths of God's forgiveness. In this verse, he declares that Jesus's blood on the cross is enough to cover any wrong he has done.

**Do you need to be washed? Why? Offer a prayer of repentance, telling God you're sorry for your sins. Then thank Him that His forgiveness is enough to cover any wrong that you have ever done and will ever do.**

**And may you remember this verse every time you see the beauty of snow!**
