

Thanksgiving MAYFLOWER BOAT








BOAT

- 1. Using template draw outline of boat on a piece of scrap 2x4 pine wood.
- 2. Cut out using a skill saw.
- 3. Sand, lightly stain if desired.
- 4. Drill two holes ½" deep for ¼" dowels: one 1 ½" from ship front, second 2 ½" from front





MASTS

BACK MAST: cut 4"

FRONT MAST: cut 3"

- 1. Cut two ¼" thick dowels to above lengths.
- 2. Cut the top of both masts off at a 45 degree angle.
- 3. Cut diagonal notches into the dowels

Measuring down ½" from the top of the mast:

Cuts on the front mast=1.5" apart

On back mast=2" apart

4. Glue dowels into holes with notches facing forward & angled to one side.







SAILS

- 1. Using sails templates, trace onto cardstock one large and one small sail.
- 2. Insert small one on foremast and larger one on main mast
